Annual Count

What is it?

- Report compiled within 1st half of year using previous calendar year's data
- Historical record of literally homeless counts and demographics for a given year
- Statewide data used for State of Homelessness report published by MSHDA

The Annual Count Should be Used For:

COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT

- Educate and advocate locally!
- Communicate trends and outcomes important to your community

DISCUSSION/DEVELOPMENT

- Facilitate the discussion and development of CoC action plans
- Set target benchmarks and monitor for improvement
- Data driven decision making!


COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT

- Keep on hand for a consistent resource to community data
- Tool that ensures the CoC has a unified voice, base knowledge and understanding for the past, present, and future

Literal Homeless Count (with household type breakdown)

The unduplicated overall literally homeless count (HUD Category 1 Homeless) for the Kalamazoo CoC in 2018 was 3,065. 37% were single adults, 30% were children in families 32% were adults in families, and 1% were unaccompanied youth. Adult/child households made up $\frac{2}{3}$ of the overall homeless population by household type.

2018 Kalamazoo Homeless Count




Note: household count breakdowns are not unduplicated and thus will not add up to equal the overall unduplicated count.

Literal Homeless Count: Basic Demographics

61% of those that are literally homeless are female, 38% are male, and 1% are transgender men and women or nonbinary.

Large racial disparities exist within the CoC. The black/African American population in the county overall is 11%, but accounts for 64% of those facing literal homelessness.



Domestic Violence

41% of literally homeless persons identified as a domestic violence victim/survivor.

Of that 41%, one third reported an occurrence within the past 3 months.

2018 Homeless Sub-Population Demographics

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Average Single Adult Experiencing Homelessness

1,180 homeless single adults were served in 2018. The average single adult experiencing literal homelessness is a 44-year-old female with a disabling condition.

Average Family Experiencing Homelessness

1,983 adults and children in families without homes were served in 2018. The average family experiencing literal homelessness consists of a female single parent, 32 years of age, with a child of the average age of 7.

Chronic Homeless Demographics

176 people were identified as chronically homeless in 2018. Chronic homelessness is defined by HUD as being in a literal homeless situation for 12 or more cumulative months within a 3 year span <u>and</u> having a documented disability.

Unaccompanied Youth (Under 18) Homeless Demographics

62 unaccompanied youth (ages 11-17) were identified in 2018. The average unaccompanied youth experiencing literal homelessness is a 15-year-old male.

Senior Homelessness Demographics

306 seniors (aged 55+) were identified as literally homeless in 2018. The average senior experiencing literal homelessness is a 60-year-old male.
