IMPORTANT FACTS ABOUT SUBSIDIZED AND AFFORDABLE HOUSING

HOUSING CHOICE VOUCHER (HCV) PROGRAM

Kalamazoo County issues limited numbers of Housing Choice Vouchers to eligible individuals and families. Having a Housing Choice Voucher allows a renter to select a unit of his/her choice provided that unit meets HCV requirements and inspection standards. A qualified renter will pay no more than 40% of his/her income for rent. Housing Choice Vouchers can be transferred to another unit as long as all guidelines have been met (this is different than HUD Subsidized or Project Based Vouchers...see below). Opportunities to apply for Housing Choice Vouchers arise only when the current waiting list has been depleted.

HUD SUBSIDIZED APARTMENTS

Some types of rental assistance are "attached" to specific units. These Subsidized units and Project Based Vouchers (PBV) are different than having a Housing choice Vouchers (HCV) (see above). If you move out of a HUD Subsidized unit, you cannot transfer the rental assistance with you to your new home. A qualified renter pays 30% to 40% of his or her income for rent. It is necessary to apply to each individual complex for consideration. The more complexes and programs you apply to, the better chance you have of obtaining a subsidized housing unit.
